Policies and Procedures

1. Pre-registration is strongly recommended: Classes usually fit up very quickly. Upon receipt of your payment, a position in your requested class will be held for you. Any cancellations, requiring a refund, must be made at least 2 weeks prior to the start up date.
2. Payment: Cheques payable to Louise Kingsley, can be mailed to or dropped off at:

 - Please enclose a completed and printed registration form with your payment.
3. Class Credits: These are available to anyone who cannot complete their present set of classes will be given the opportunity to attend in the next term, providing there is space available.
4. Accidents: We understand that dogs and especially puppies can become nervous or excited when they are new at class. Each student is required to bring with them, a plastic bag and paper towels in case of an accident. We will consider this a gift from your dog and insist that you take it, in its entirety, home with you!
5. Family Members: Including children, are welcome to come to class at any time as long as they are able to sit quietly in the viewing area.
6. Class Disruptions: Many dogs come to us with barking or aggressive problems. Most of these problems are usually rectified quickly, however, we reserve the right to refuse classes to anyone whose dog continually disrupts the class or who poses another threat to another person or dog.
7. Emergencies: Our service fee for emergencies is \$50 and can be paid by cash or money order. However, if you have attended the Emergency Procedures lecture, the fee will be waived.
8. Chain training collars: Are required at class except for young dogs. Halters, haltees, and restricted collars are not allowed in class. If you are unsure, please contact us either by e-mail or by telephone.
9. Referral Bonus Policy: Each student will be given a Referral Card. This card will be initialed for you each time someone you referred signs up for private or group classes. Bonuses to be announced.
10. Release and Waiver: Each new student will be required to sign a Release and Waiver before beginning his or her class.
